**OFFICIAL FINANCIAL THRESHOLDS RELATING TO PUBLIC PROCUREMENT,  
UTILITIES PROCUREMENT AND CONCESSION CONTRACTS  
EU DIRECTIVES**

The European Union (EU) establishes Minimum Standardised Rules for Procurement, the Financial Estimated Value of which equals or exceeds a certain Threshold. Every two (2) years, such thresholds need to be revised in accordance with the terms of the World Trade Organisation Agreement on Government Procurement<sup>1</sup> (GPA).

The revised thresholds, which have been revised downwards for Years 2026 – 2027 shall apply as of 1<sup>st</sup> January 2026.

**Public/Utilities Procurement and Concession Contracts: EU Thresholds**

The new EU Financial Estimated Value Thresholds excluding VAT, by EU Directive, are as detailed below and overleaf. Through the publication of a Legal Notice/s, the corresponding Thresholds shall be reflected in the relevant ‘Schedule’ of the local Procurement/Concession Legislations.

## **OFFICIAL FINANCIAL THRESHOLDS**

The European Union (EU) establishes Minimum Standardised Rules for Procurement, the Financial Estimated Value of which equals or exceeds a certain Threshold<sup>1</sup>. Every two (2) years, such thresholds need to be revised<sup>2</sup> in accordance with the terms of the World Trade Organisation Agreement on Government Procurement (GPA)<sup>3</sup>. The purpose of these adjustments<sup>4</sup> is to correct any currency movements between the Euro and the Special Drawing Rights (SDRs).

To this end, further to the publishing of the relevant Commission Delegated Regulations<sup>5</sup> on the Official Journal of the European Union (OJEU)<sup>6</sup>, Article 8 of the Directive 2014/23/EU<sup>7</sup>, Article 4 of Directive 2014/24/EU<sup>8</sup> and Article 15 of Directive 2014/25/EU<sup>9</sup> have been amended so that the thresholds correspond to the thresholds established in the amended GPA<sup>10</sup>.

Further to the above and in accordance with Regulation 9(3) of the Public Procurement Regulations S.L. 601.03<sup>11</sup>, Regulation 30(2) of the Utilities<sup>12</sup> Procurement Regulations S.L. 601.05<sup>13</sup> and Regulation 57 of the Concession Contracts Regulations S.L. 601.09<sup>14</sup>, the Minister responsible for Finance shall revise the applicable thresholds, which shall be equal to and categorised in the same manner, as the thresholds established pursuant to the relevant European Union Directives. Accordingly, through the publication of a Legal Notice/s, the respective EU Thresholds shall be reflected in the relevant ‘Schedule’ of the local Procurement/Concession Legislations. Furthermore, any other applicable Local Thresholds shall also be revised as necessary.

<sup>1</sup> The harmonised rules for procurement is presumed to be of cross-border interest. The EU rules ensure that the award of contracts of above EU threshold procurement must be fair, equitable, transparent and non-discriminatory. On the other hand, procurement which is below the EU threshold shall adhere to national rules, which nevertheless have to respect general principles of EU Legislation.

The GPA has a mechanism for recalculating the equivalent value of its thresholds, which are fixed in SDRs, in the currencies of its parties every two years.

<sup>4</sup> The calculation of the Thresholds of the Public/Utilities Procurement and Concession Directives is based on the average daily value of the Euro in terms of the Special Drawing Rights, over a period of 24 months, terminating on 31<sup>st</sup> August preceding the revision<sup>4</sup>, with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> January. The said calculation carried out every two (2) years. The said calculation is a mathematical technical exercise wherein the purpose of the adjustments is to correct any currency movements between the signatories which would affect the extent of their procurement markets which are open to competition from companies in other signatory countries.

## Public/Utilities Procurement and Concession Contracts: Local Thresholds

Pursuant to the EU and Local Financial Thresholds, a Departmental Procurement<sup>15</sup> shall be deemed to be procurement in line with the below Estimated Procurement Values.

- Public Procurement Regulations S.L. 601.03: Less than € 140,000 excl. VAT.
- Utilities Procurement Regulations S.L. 601.05: Less than € 432,000 excl. VAT.

For ease of reference and perusal, at Annex II [Sheet B] the ‘*Local Financial Thresholds*’ (specifying which authority is responsible for the Procurement/Concession Procedure, thus, the publication of the relevant Procurement/Concession Call) applicable to local Public Contracts, as of 1<sup>st</sup> January 2026 is being provided.

### Department of Contracts: Publication of Procurement Calls

The *Operations Directorate* at the Department of Contracts shall publish and administer procurement on behalf of the Contracting Authorities/Entities, in line with the details and Estimated Procurement Values as specified in the Table below.

Hence, Utilities Procurement Documents shall not be vetted by the Department of Contracts.

## e-Procurement Templates

Contracting Authorities<sup>17</sup>/Entities<sup>18</sup> shall utilise the ‘Above Threshold’ e-Procurement Template when drafting and compiling the Procurement Document whenever the Estimated Procurement Value of the Services/Supplies/Works Equals or Exceeds the Thresholds displayed in the Table below.

In line with the above, the relevant Authority responsible for publishing Procurement Calls shall distinguish between ‘Below’ and ‘Above’ Local and EU Threshold Procurement, thus, administering the Procurement Procedure according to the applicable Regulations, Policies and Modus Operandi.
